Re: Assigned Risk Commercial Coding Updates

The Iowa Division of Insurance and Ohio Department of Insurance has allowed the introduction of a Zone 98 to the Commercial Automobile Insurance Plans for when an auto does not have a street address of principal garaging or is operated beyond a 500-mile radius from either the street address of principal garaging or the headquarters if the auto does not have an address of principal garaging.

Also, the Florida Department of Financial Services and the Kansas Insurance Department have approved withdrawal of the Garage coverage form for the Florida Joint Underwriting Association and Kansas Automobile Insurance Plan. As a result, the classification codes utilized to capture these risks are no longer applicable and are being removed.

These changes apply to policies effective January 1, 2025, and subsequent. The updated coding will be reflected in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2025 revisions to the NISS Automobile Volume I Statistical Plan.
